Addition game 20.4.20

What you need

Number cards 1-10

20 small items – could be lego bricks, coins, stones etc

A plastic cup or bowl

Your homework book and pencil

What to do

- 1. Choose a number card and count out that many objects into a cup or bowl.
- 2. Leave the number card next to the pot to help you remember how many things there are in the pot.
- 3. Choose another number card and count out that many objects.
- 4. How many objects have you got altogether? What will you do to find out?
- 5. Now show in your homework book what you have done using pictures or numbers.
- 6. Put the cards and objects back and do it all again.
