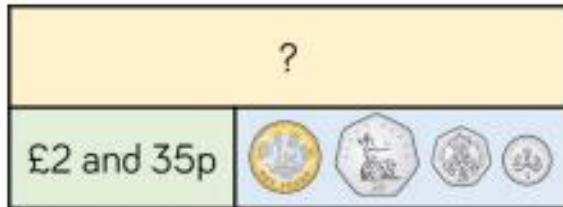


Money challenge sheet

A magazine costs £1 and 75p.
