If the 'f' sound is tricky look in the mirror. Place your top front teeth on your lip and blow.</p>  <p>(Can you think of any other words that start with the 'f' sound?)</p> <p>★ ★</p>	<p>Can you follow a simple recipe to bake something delicious? Help to get the ingredients ready and carefully weigh the correct amount.</p>  <p>Shortbread or flapjack is very easy to make and doesn't need lots of ingredients- you can also add dried fruit/chocolate chips etc (Yummy!)</p> <p>★ ★ ★ ★</p>	 <p>Draw a picture of a beanstalk reaching up into the clouds in your home learning book... Can you tell your teddy what your favourite food is?</p>  <p>★ ★ ★</p>	<p>Help an adult to make a sandwich for your picnic. Hold the knife carefully to spread the butter. When you have finished cut your sandwich in half. Are both sides the same size? What shape have you cut your sandwich into?</p>  <p>★ ★ ★</p>	<p>Help out at home by sorting socks!
