Here are some phonics ideas to try at home:

Can you teach someone at home a nursery rhyme? See if you can remember some that we sing at Nursery- Can you remember the words and do the actions?

If you can't remember any there are lots of nursery rhymes on You tube.

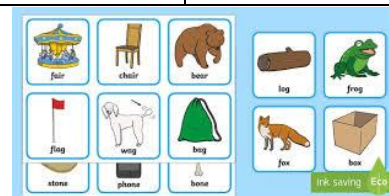
Charlotte Chef is making some silly sounds soup! Each soup needs 3 ingredients that start with the same letter sound. She has already made the 't' sound soup with toffees, tomatoes and toast! Can you think of 3 foods to put in the 'c' sound soup? Draw them in your home learning book.

Look in a mirror and make some letter sounds. Look at the shape of your mouth. What happens to your lips / teeth / tongue? Can you make the sounds: 'a' (apple), 'm' (mummy), 's' (snake), 'b' (ball), 'f' (fish), 't' (tiger), 'l' (lion) 'sh' (sheep), 'th' (think)

Play a rhyming game using the rhyming picture cards PDF (If you don't have a printer you could draw some or find objects at home). Remember to listen carefully for the sound at the end of the word. Can you match two picture cards together that rhyme – e.g. 'fox' and 'box' If this is difficult it can help if an adult says the words, emphasising the rhyme – e.g. f-ox, b-ox

When you are out on a walk go on a letter hunt. What letters can you spot on road signs /shop fronts/ cars / houses. Can you spot any of the letters from your name?

Practise carefully writing the letters from your name in lots of different ways- it could be in sand/in bubbles in the bath/in cornflour with water/with water and a paintbrush outside/in rainbow felt tip colours
