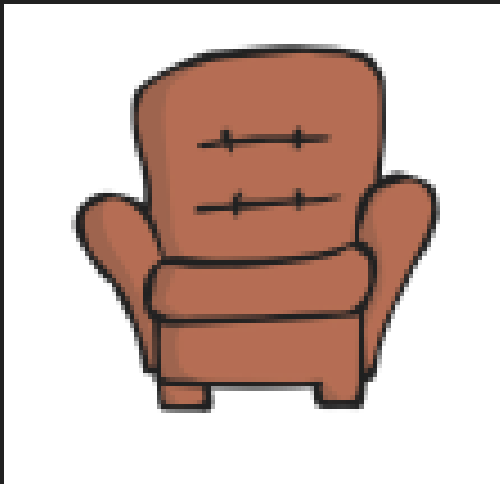
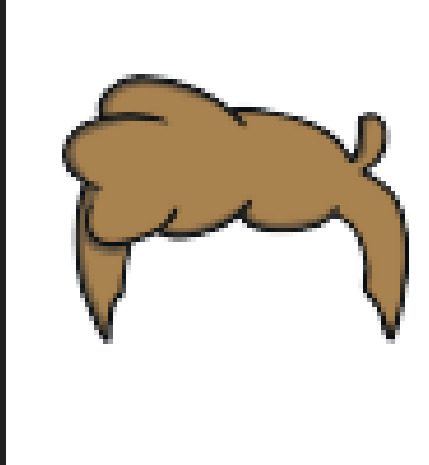
Hi guys! Hope you've all had a lovely half term. This week we are looking at our final phase 3 phoneme, another trigraph: /ure/

/ure/ can be tricky, as it sometimes sounds different in different words. In words like **pure**, the ure sounds like the word 'your.' In words like **sure**, the ure sounds like the word 'or.' And sometimes ure makes an 'uh' sound at the end of the word like in **picture**. Tricky, but we'll figure it out together!

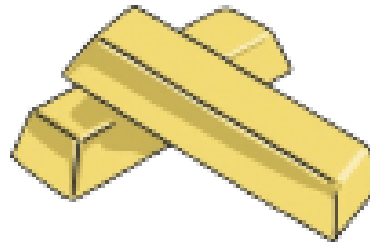
