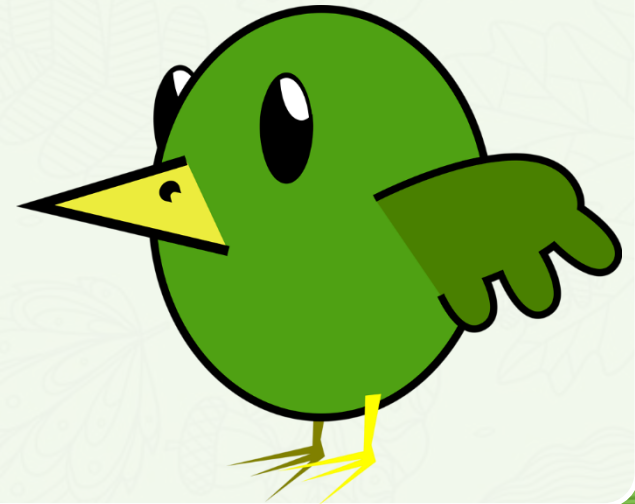

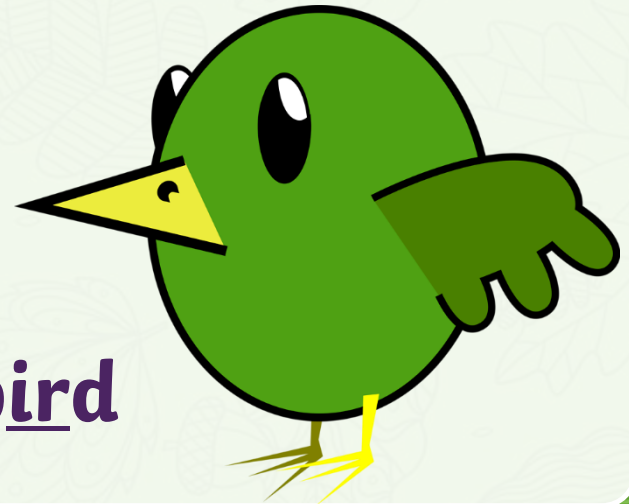

# Miss Whitney's Phonics

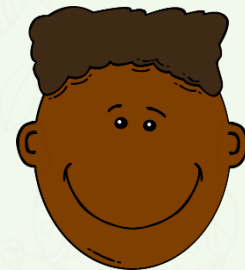
Hi everyone!

1) In **tea** it makes the long /ee/ sound like in 'tree'

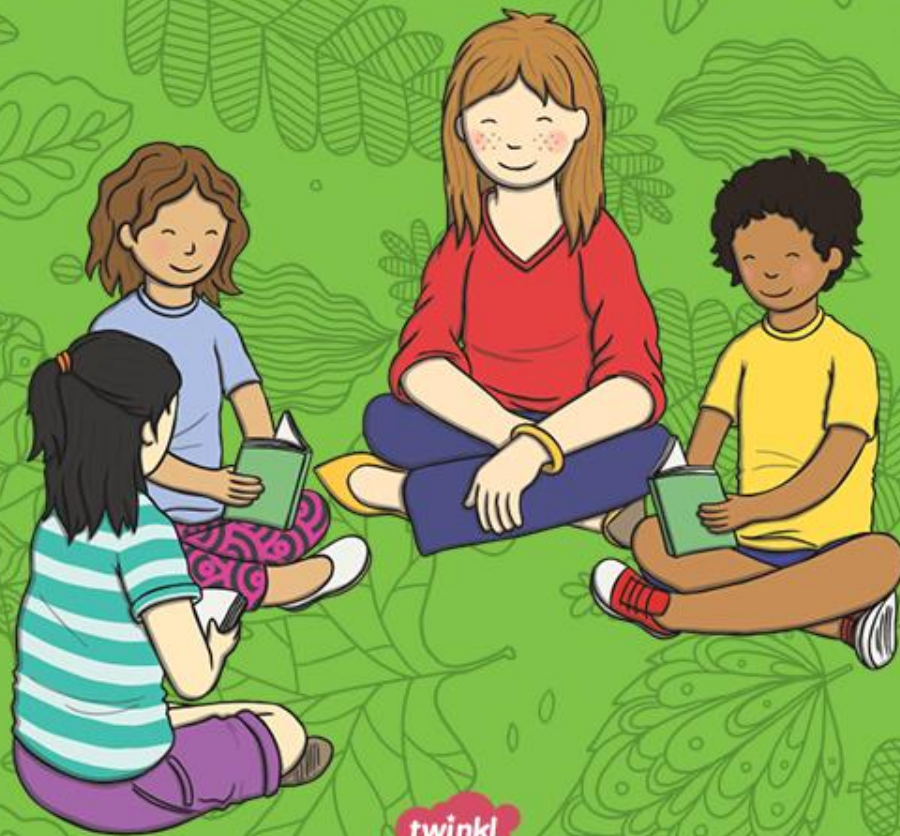


2) In **head** it makes the short /e/ sound like in 'bed'

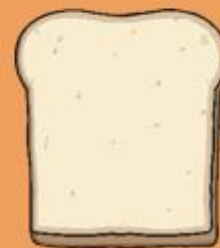

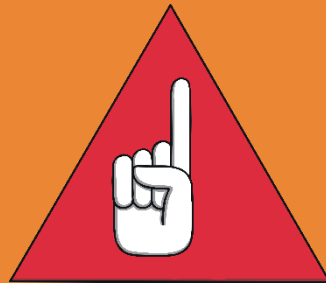
