I can use **connectives** in my sentences.

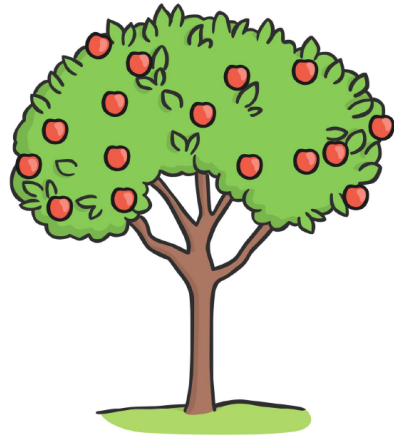


I can use awesome **adjectives** in my sentences.

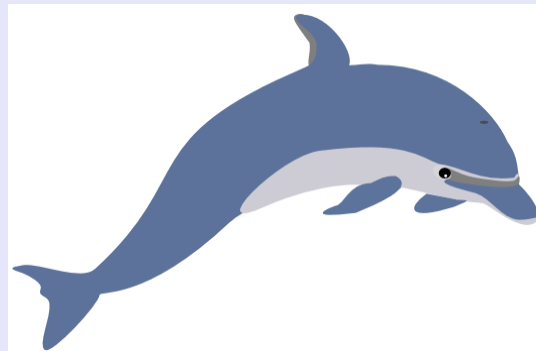
