List words under the THRASS boxes that have the 'ch' digraph making the different sounds.

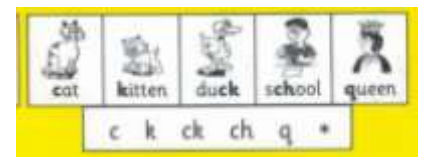
