

Week 2 Phonics – y, z, qu

Over the week feel free to try these simple phonics lessons with your child. They should also find these sounds on their THRASS chart and have a THRASS chart to hand to help their learning.

Day One - Phonics sound 1- y

Activity 1: Reading

On a phone, tablet or computer go to <https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/2/buried-treasure> select phase 3- y. Put the real words in the treasure chest and the fake words in the bin.

Activity 2: Writing

Have a go at writing the words with your child.

Show them how to write it in a sentence or encourage them to do this independently. (The fox went yip yip)

Activity 1: Reading

On a phone, tablet or computer go to <https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/2/buried-treasure> select phase 3- z. Put the real words in the treasure chest and the fake words in the bin.

Activity 2: Writing

Have a go at writing the words with your child.

Show them how to write it in a sentence or encourage them to do this independently. (The bag had a zip.)

Day Three - Phonics sound 3- qu

Activity 1: Reading

On a phone, tablet or computer go to <https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/2/buried-treasure> select phase 3- qu. Put the real words in the treasure chest and the fake words in the bin.

Activity 2: Writing

Have a go at writing the words quick, quit and queen with your child.

Show them how to write it in a sentence or encourage them to do this independently. (The cat is quick.)

Phase 3 phonics:

Set 6: j, v, w, x Set 7: y, z, zz, qu Consonant digraphs: ch, sh, th, ng Vowel digraphs and trigraphs: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er.
