Subtraction game 27.4.20

What you need

Number cards 1-10

10 small items – could be lego bricks, coins, stones etc

Plastic/paper plate

Your homework book and pencil

What to do

- 1. Put your number cards into 2 piles. 1-5 in pile one and 6-10 in pile two.
- 2. Choose a number card from pile 2 (6-10) and count out that many objects onto your plate.
- 3. Choose a number card from pile 1 (1-5) and subtract (take away) that many from the ones on your plate.
- 4. How many objects have you got left?
- 5. Now show in your homework book what you have done using pictures or numbers.
- 6. Put the cards and objects back and do it all again.

Have fun playing the game.

Extension:

- 1. Make up your own subtraction stories and record them in your homework book.
- 2. Starting with 10 objects each time, how many different subtraction stories can you make up and record?
