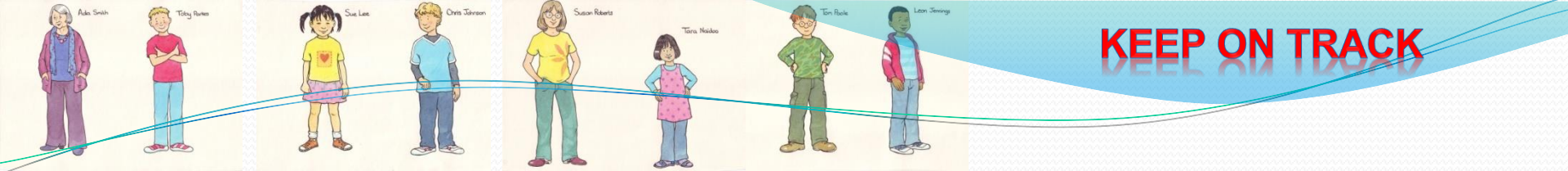




What did you notice?

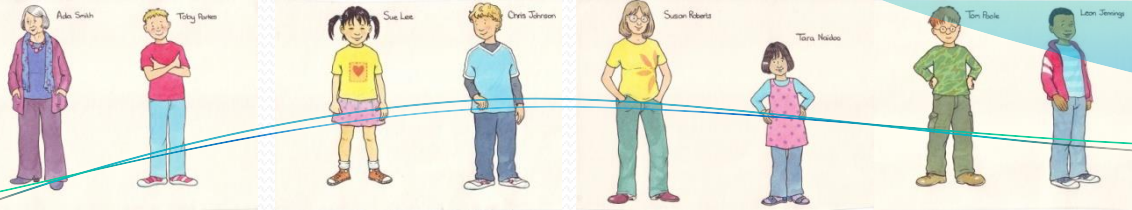
- Cleaning products like bleach were left without a lid
