

## **Week 2 Phonics – oa oo oo**

This week we are going over oa, oo and oo. The first oo is in moon on the THRASS chart and makes a long OO sound where as the second oo is in the word book and makes a sure “uh” sound. This is a good place to discuss with your child how some graphemes (letters) can make different sounds.

### **Day One - Phonics sound 1- oa**

### **Phase 3 phonics:**

**Set 6:** j, v, w, x **Set 7:** y, z, zz, qu **Consonant digraphs:** ch, sh, th, ng **Vowel digraphs and trigraphs:** ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er.
