"All About...."

You will need small objects for counting, 3 circles or plates, pencils or crayons and your workbook.

- 1. Choose which number you are going to find out about 6, 8 or 12 and write that in the middle of your page.
- 2. Can you draw that many objects?
- 3. Can you think of something that is represented by that number? eg a bee has 6 legs.
- 4. Can you show how to share that number of objects fairly between 2 or 3 people?
- 5. Can you use the part/whole model to represent that number in different ways?
- 6. Can you use those different ways to help you write addition and subtraction number sentences?
- 7. What else can you do to show that number?
