lunes	loo-ness	Monday
martes	mar-tess	Tuesday
miércoles	me-yeah-co-less	Wednesday
jueves	who-ev-ess	Thursday
viernes	vee-yeah-ness	Friday
sábado	sab-ah-doh	Saturday
domingo	doh-min-go	Sunday

Notice that Spanish days of the week do not have capital letters!
