

Heymann Homeworking Menu – Reception - Week Beginning: 25.5.20



In the table, there are lots of different homework activities to choose from. **Half term activities are shown below if you want to continue doing activities with your child at home.**

Ask an adult to blow up a balloon for you. How long can you keep it off the ground? Can you pass it around your family?



Make a sock puppet. See the attached sheet for ideas. Can you make a puppet show using your sock puppet for your family to watch?



Be a conductor. Listen to some classical music. Using chopsticks or straws, pretend to conduct the orchestra – showing when the music is faster/slower or louder/quieter. [Eg Handel's Water Music](#)

Talk to an adult at home about what you have got better at since doing your all your learning at home and what would you like to improve. Design a certificate to celebrate your successes.

Choose a favourite book. Draw the main characters, colour them in and cut them out. Make them into puppets using lolly sticks, straws or sticks of card. Can you retell the story using your puppets? What about making some props for your puppet show?

Make a lolly stick picture frame. Add a self portrait picture inside the frame. Remember to look carefully at yourself in a mirror to see colours and features. [Here are some examples](#)

Build a den inside or outside. Take a photo of it so we can see what you have done.



Count steps. How many steps is it from your bedroom to the bathroom, or from the living room to the kitchen? Try different routes around your house and garden and count the number of steps. Find a way to record your steps.

Write a postcard to someone special. Tell them what you have been doing on one side and draw a picture on the other side. Save it for them until you see them.
