Cereal!

This week, you will learn all about cereal. There will be a mixture of activities on this page that will help you to understand where cereal comes from. As well as how to make your own cereal boxes and advertise your cereal to your friends! Before you start I want you to think about what you already know about cereal. Write everything you know in your book and then see what new facts you can find out and add them to your list.

DT

This work will help you to understand where cereal comes from and how it is made. Look at the 'DT Cereal Sheet' to find some activities and videos to help you. You can record what you have learned in your exercise book by writing a list, making a poster or writing some 5 tick sentences all about cereal!

English

This work is going to help you to make your cereal boxes. Follow the steps on the 'English Cereal Sheet' to learn how to write your ingredients list, cereal description and tag line. Once you have written them, you can add them to your box. Watch Miss Johnston's video to see what she wrote, it might give you some ideas for your own!

DT and art

Follow Miss Johnston's video while you are working to see how to create your box step by step.

You will need:

- An empty cereal box
- Scissors
- Paper
- Coloured pencils/felt tips
- Your English work
- Glue

Extra activities:

- Create an advert for your cereal by filming it on your tablet, laptop or phone (with your parents help) and send it to your teachers for the blog.
- Make a poster to explain why your friends should buy your cereal.
- Read 'The Wheat we Eat' on Scholastic.
- Look at the cereal in your house and read the ingredients list. Did they use the same as you? Is there anything you have never heard of before?
