












Heymann Homeworking Menu – Nursery - Week Beginning: 15.06.20 (Sheet 10)

Can you remember what the tiger ate in the story? Where did Sophie go for her tea at the end of the story? Who did she go with? What would you feed a tiger if one came to your house?</p>  <p>★★★★</p>	<p>Colour mixing – Using paints can you colour mix? What different colours can you make? Check out Miss Inglis' video on our web page. If you don't have paints you could use felt tips, coloured playdough or coloured water.</p>  <p>★★★★</p>	<p>Phonics – Zoe the zookeeper wanted to name some of her animals. She wants the names to start with the same letter sound as the animal. So far she has thought of Charlie Chimp and Tommy Tiger. Can you help her think of some names for her Lion, Snake and Panda? You could draw pictures of them in your home learning books too.</p>  <p>★★★★</p>
