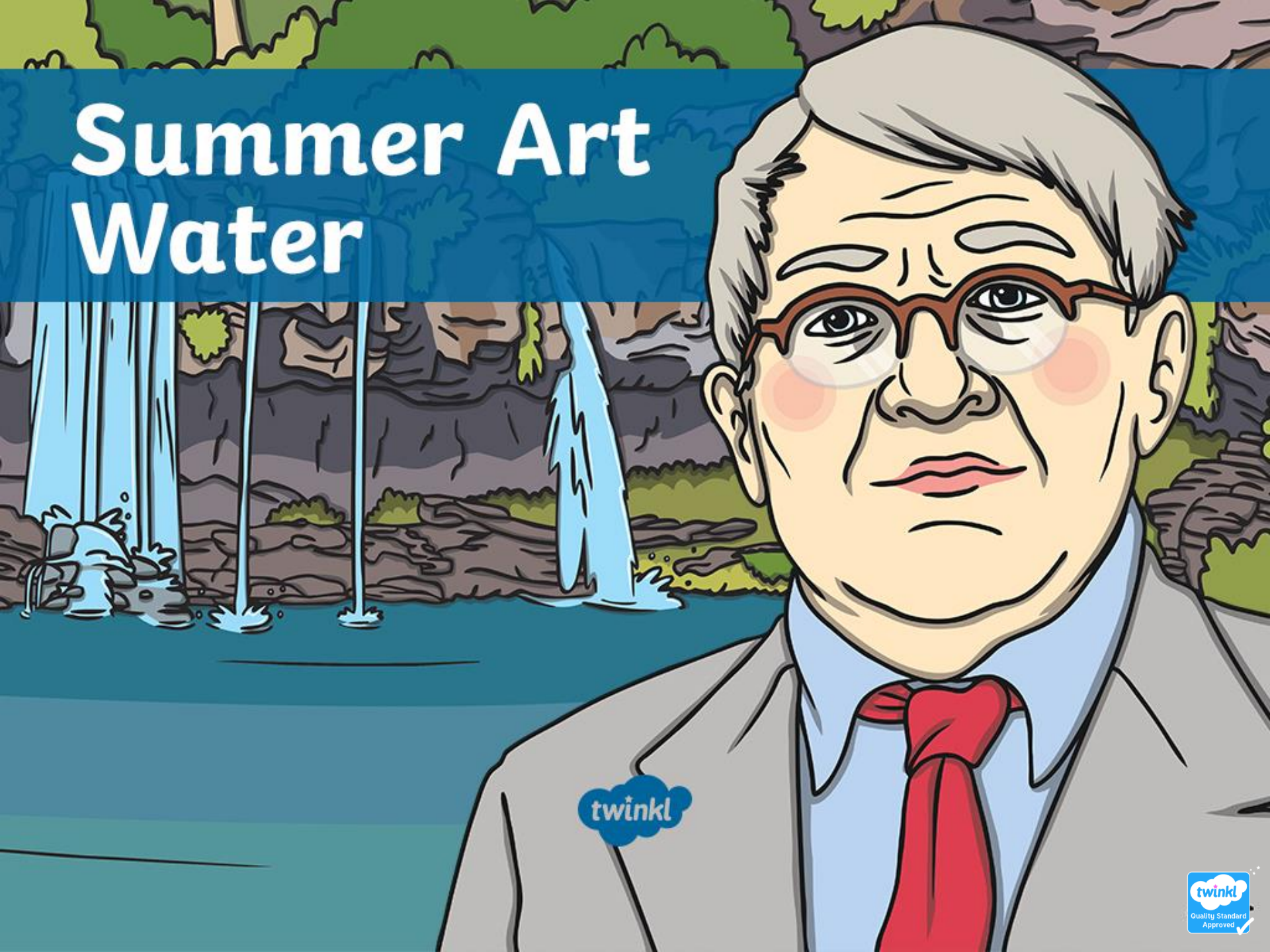

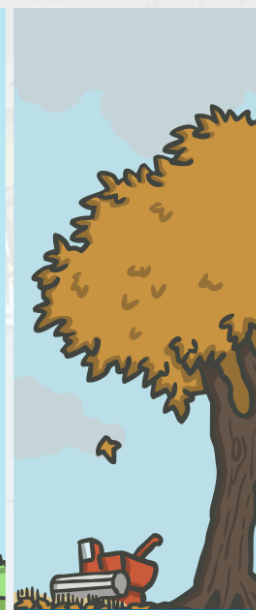

Water

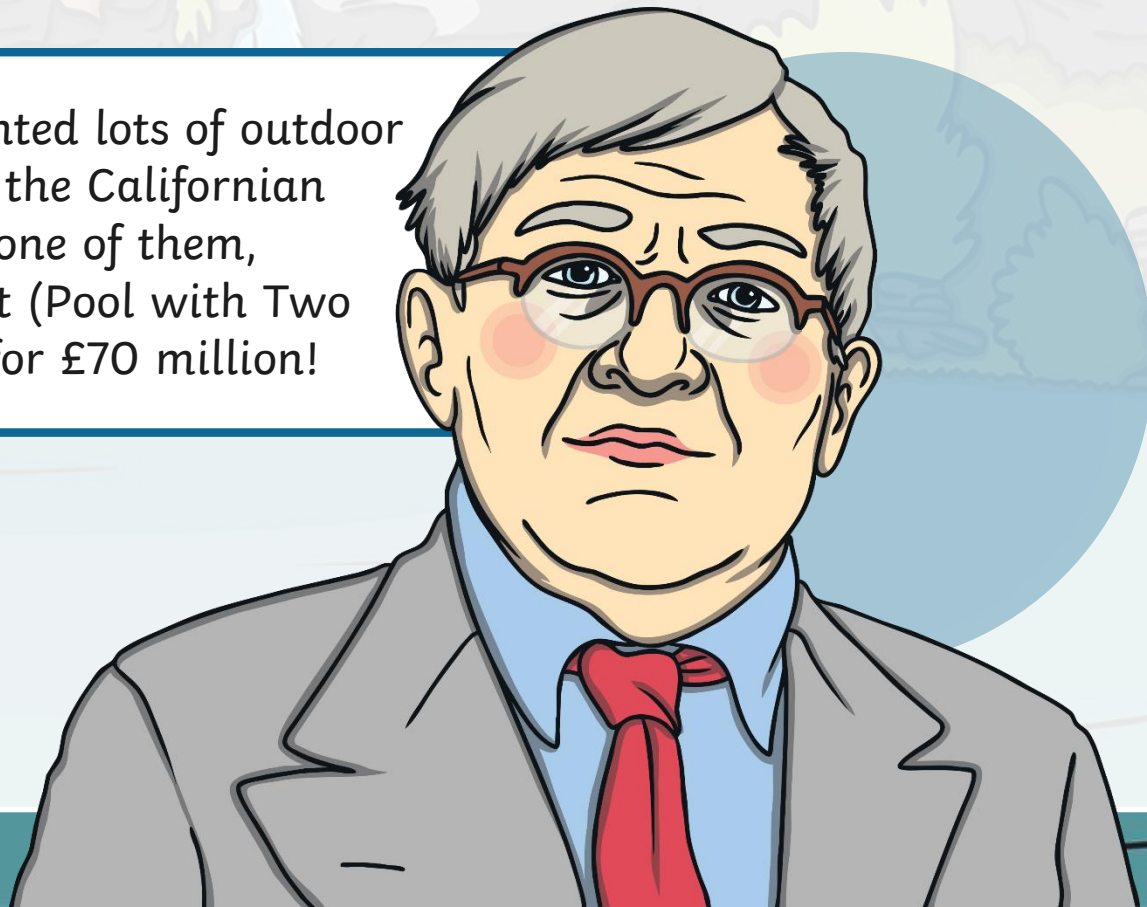
In the summer, there are more hours of sunlight.

He painted it in 2015.

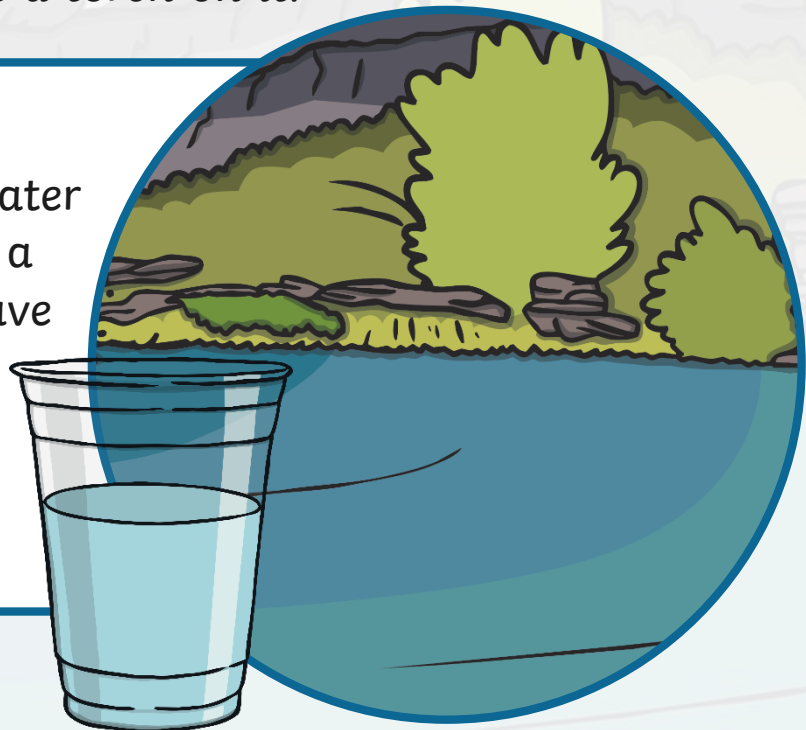


How is this painting different from the other two?

Sunshine on Water

Put some water in a clear glass. If it's a sunny day, put the water where the light will hit it. You could take the glass outside and put it in full sunlight. If not, you could shine a torch on it.

Think about other places you see water outside in the sunshine. It could be a river, the sea or a lake. You may have visited an outdoor swimming pool. On a sunny day, some people put up a paddling pool.



Try It

You are going to create your own summer outdoor swimming pool painting inspired by David Hockney's paintings.

Things to think about:

- How many shades of blue will you use? How will you make these different shades?
- What other colours will you add to the pool?
- Will your water be still or rippling? If it's moving, how will you show movement?
- What else will be in your painting?
