1. Start with who you are writing to ...

2. Structure your letter into paragraphs. You could cover some or all of these topics:

Personal Details - who are you?
Home and Family - where do you live? E.g. West Bridgford, Wilford, Colwick (don't give your actual address) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- who lives with you?- do you have any pets?
Hobbies and Interests - what do you do in your spare time?
School - what do you enjoy learning about? <ul style="list-style-type: none">- what do you do well in?- what do you need help with?- who do you work well with?
In the Future - what are you doing in the holidays? <ul style="list-style-type: none">- what are you most looking forward to doing in Year 6?
Resilience - what are your worries? <ul style="list-style-type: none">- how do you intend to cope with starting a new school year after this period of lockdown?- how will you try to keep a positive mindset?

Remember to use your best writing:

- neat handwriting;
- accurate spelling and punctuation;
- lively vocabulary and content.
