Challenge Words Review Instructions

- 1. Open the Year 5 and 6 Challenge Words Checklist. This is a list of important words which you should be able to read, spell and use correctly by the end of Year 6.
- As you can see, the 50 words we have covered this half term have been highlighted for you. Begin by identifying which words you can already read by reading them out loud to an adult. Tick them off when you are successful.
- 3. Now you need to work out which of the highlighted words you can spell successfully. Do this by either asking someone else to test you, or by testing yourself using the look, cover, write, check method. Again, tick off the ones you are confident with.
- 4. For the words you still find difficult to spell, use your preferred learning methods to practice them. We have identified 10 particularly tricky words and provided extra materials for targetting these on the webpage. These words are: accommodate, convenience, conscious, conscience, desperate, disastrous, immediate, interfere, mischievous, pronunciation.
- 5. At the end of the week, test again to see if you have learnt them and tick off as before.
- 6. Use the wordsearches and crosswords to revisit the words.
- 7. Remember to go on Spelling Shed to practise the words.
- Over the summer holidays, work you way through the rest of the words, checking you can read, spell and use them correctly. This will be a great way to prepare for starting Year 6 positively.
