Log in to Letterjoin (access details are on the Year 1 website page). Watch the video clips for the letters – a and d. Practise your Heymann handwriting of these letters, copying exactly how the video clips show you.	Construction Challenge: Make a model of the 3 bears' cottage. This could be using lego, a dolls house, crafting with old cereal boxes, anything you can find at home!	Maths Challenges: Go on the Year 1 Webpage to access the daily Maths Challenge Sheet. How many challenges can you complete?	PE: Practise your skipping, running, jumping and hopping. Watch Mrs Sawford's video to see what you need to do!
