


Look which column changes each time

The units column goes up by one when we add 1 more. The tens column stays the same until we reach the next 10.



The units column goes down by 1 when we add 1 more.


The tens column stays the same until we reach the 10 before.

What is 1 less than —?



The tens column goes down by one when we find 10 less.


The units column always stays the same.
