What goes in the green section?

The subject - what the sentence is about. There can be more than 1 subject. This is the star of the sentence.

The small cat sat on the mat.

What goes the orange section?

The predicate - tells you what the subject did or what happened.
A predicate always contains a verb. There can be more than one predicate in a sentence.

The small cat sat on the mat.

What goes in the red section?

The stop - completes the sentence with punctuation e.g. a full stop, exclamation mark and question mark.

The small cat sat on the mat.



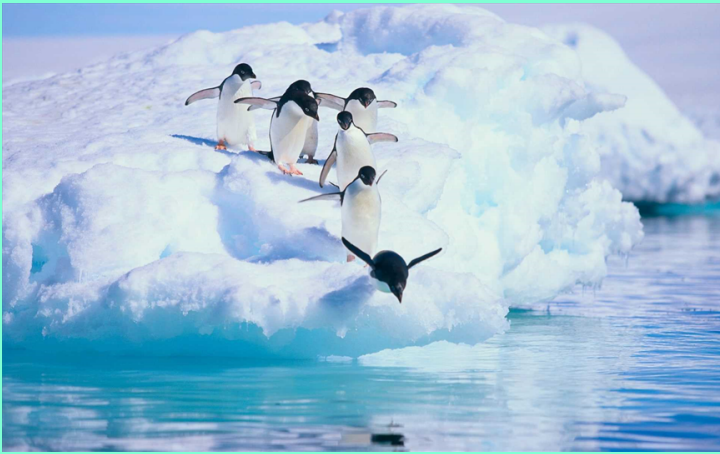

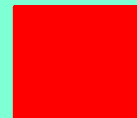
