WHAT ARE SATS?

- Children are assessed in;
English-Reading
(Grammar, punctuation and spelling)
Mathematics- Arithmetic and mathematical reasoning.
- In KS1 the emphasis is on teacher assessment, the tests support this judgement.

TASKS AND TESTS

Subject	Test paper
English reading	2 papers Short text and questions Longer text and separate questions
English grammar, punctuation and spelling (Opt out)	2 papers Spelling Punctuation and grammar
Mathematics	2 papers Arithmetic Mathematical reasoning

PHONICS SCREENING

- Normally sit in June of Year 1
- Government has decided will be sat before Christmas
- Teachers will use a past paper 1-1 with a child at a time
- Reading 40 words (real and non real), all decodable with phonics up to phase 5
- Non real words e.g. splart, shleeb
- Children are used to doing phonics and associated activities every day in class, plus 1-1 reading with teachers so this will not be presented as anything different
- Regardless of phonics screening, teachers may send extra phonics activities home at times
