biome 	a natural area of the living world which has its own climate, vegetation and animals	fauna 	the animals of a particular location	equator 	an imaginary line around the middle of the Earth at an equal distance from the North Pole and the South Pole.
climate 	the general weather conditions that are typical of a place	flora 	the plants of a particular location	evergreen 	a plant which keeps its green leaves throughout the year
climate zone 	sections of the Earth that are divided according to the climate. There are three main climate zones; polar, temperate and tropical.	polar 	relating to the North or South pole	temperate 	region with mild climate found between the tropics and polar regions in each hemisphere
deciduous 	trees or shrubs which shed their leaves annually	regeneration 	the process of renewing or restoring something or somewhere	tropics 	parts of the world that lie between two lines of latitude, the Tropic of Cancer, north of the equator, and the Tropic of Capricorn, south of the equator. The tropics have a humid climate, where the weather is hot and damp.
economy 	a country's economy is the wealth that it gets from business and industry	sustainable 	to maintain at a steady level without exhausting natural resources or causing severe environmental damage
