

Learning Intention:

Match the rhyming pairs. Most of these words can be found in the Gruffalo story, but some are new words to test your rhyming skills!

How to Play Game:

Put all the cards face down on the table. One student turns over two cards. If they rhyme they are a matching pair. If they do not match, turn the cards back over. Next participant. Continue until all cards are matched.
