## **RE Home Learning**

This term in RE we are going to be learning all about Muslim families.

Our enquiry question that we want to find out about is: What is it like to belong to a Muslim religion in Nottinghamshire today?

- First of all, we would love you to have a think about any questions you
  might like to find out the answers to about this topic. Share these with
  an adult or sibling, or write them down in your home learning book.
  Hopefully you will be able to find out some of these answers over the
  next 3 weeks.
- 2. Have a chat with an adult about what Sara does to follow her religion. Now draw a picture of Sara and write what she does to follow her religion around the page. Keep this safe as you will need to add to this later!
- 3. Over the **next 3 weeks** we are going to be learning about the 5 pillars of Islam. These are the basic rules in Islam that all Muslims must follow.

- 5. Today we are going to find out more about the first 2 pillars of Islam Shahadah (the saying that all Muslims must know off by heart). Have a look at 'Five Pillars Intro and Shahadah' PowerPoint for more information on this. The second pillar of Islam is Salah (prayer). - 6. Now have a look back at your drawing of Sara and see if you can add any more information about what you have learnt today about the 5 pillars of Islam specifically Pillar 1: Shahadah and Pillar 2: Salah. You might want to add some key words or drawings around your picture. Remember this is an ongoing topic for 3 weeks!
