Carpenter (noun)

Definition: A person who builds or repairs things made from wood

In context: The carpenter built the shed in the garden



Lyme Regis (noun)

Definition: A coastal town in Dorset

In context: We are visiting Lyme Regis in the holidays



Limp (adjective)

Definition: Not stiff or firm

In context: Sophie was limp in her grip



Teased (verb)

Definition: to make fun of or try to annoy in a playful or cruel way

In context: The boy teased his sister until she cried.

Synonyms: annoy, bother, mock



Whom (pronoun)

Definition: A person or persons

In context: India saw those whom she loved at her birthday party



Slabs (noun)

Definition: a large, thick, flat piece of stone or concrete

In context: The man laid the slabs down in his garden



Grazing (verb)

Definition: To feed on growing grass

In context: The cows were grazing in the field

Synonyms: eating, feeding

Quarrymen (noun)

Definition: A worker in a quarry

In context: The quarrymen lifted heavy rock all day long



Snakestone (noun)

Definition: Another name for ammonite because of the shape of it

In context: The snakestone was found buried under layers of sedimentary rock



Swirled (verb)

Definition: To move around in a spinning motion

In context: The waves swirled and crashed against the sea.

Synonyms: twirl, whirl
