

Art and Design Home Learning – Design and make a mosque

- In RE we have been learning all about Muslim families. We have learnt that the mosque is a special place for Muslim families, as it is where they go to pray and be together.
- Your task for the next 2 weeks in art is to design and make a mosque! This week, we would like you to complete the planning sheet here '[Design and make a mosque planning sheet](#)' and it can also be found on the website.
- The evaluation will need to be completed **after** you have made your mosque, so, next week).
- On your planning sheet you will need to draw a picture of what your mosque is going to look like and write a couple of sentences to it next to your drawing. Then you will need to write a bit about what types of materials you will use to make your mosque. We suggest that you use recycled materials from around your homes – maybe cardboard, used tins, boxes etc!
Tip: you might want to start collecting some recycled materials this week as your task next week will be to actually make your mosques and finish evaluating it!
