Spot and use the “oo” sound



Today we are looking for the ue sound that can be found in words like **boom**, **screw** and **true**. The words must make the long /oo/ sound. For example, book wouldn't count because even though the **spelling** is the same, the sound is different: in book the **oo** makes a short /u/ sound like in cup.

The * represents a 'grapheme catch-all'. We have talked about this lots in school. This is where you put words that have the long /oo/ sound in them, but they are spelled a different way. For example, in the word 'you' the long /oo/ sound is represented by **ou**.
