
People with a faith have special places.

Look at these places on the next slide and click on each in turn.






Well-trisias begine - with lam

Here is a prayer hall inside a Mosque.







Have you noticed any main differences between the appearance of the Muslim mosques and the Hindu temples.




Hindus use statues for their deities. Muslims don't draw figures or make statues of people or animals.

Hindus worship at shrines set up in the home.








This is the door to a place of worship of another religion.

Look inside a synagogue.






What features can you spot?
