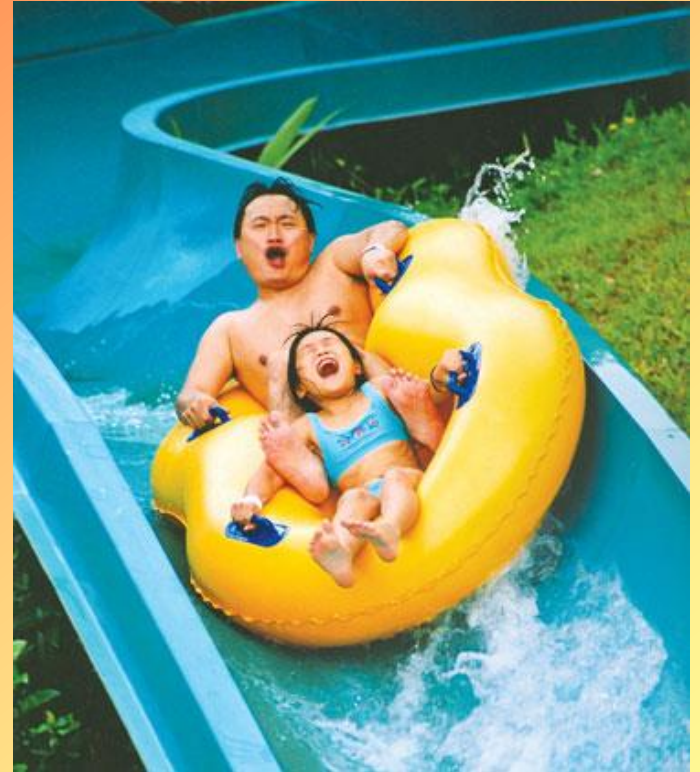

Discuss it with a partner, then as a class.



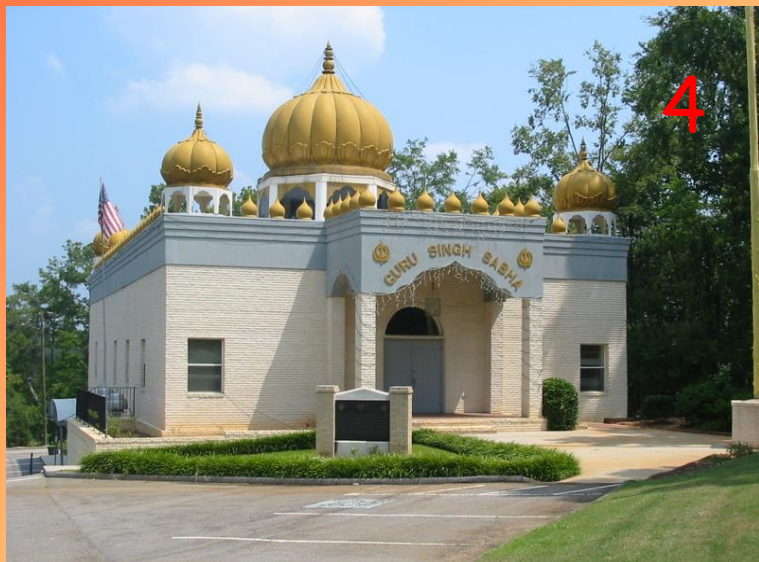

Can you see any clues?



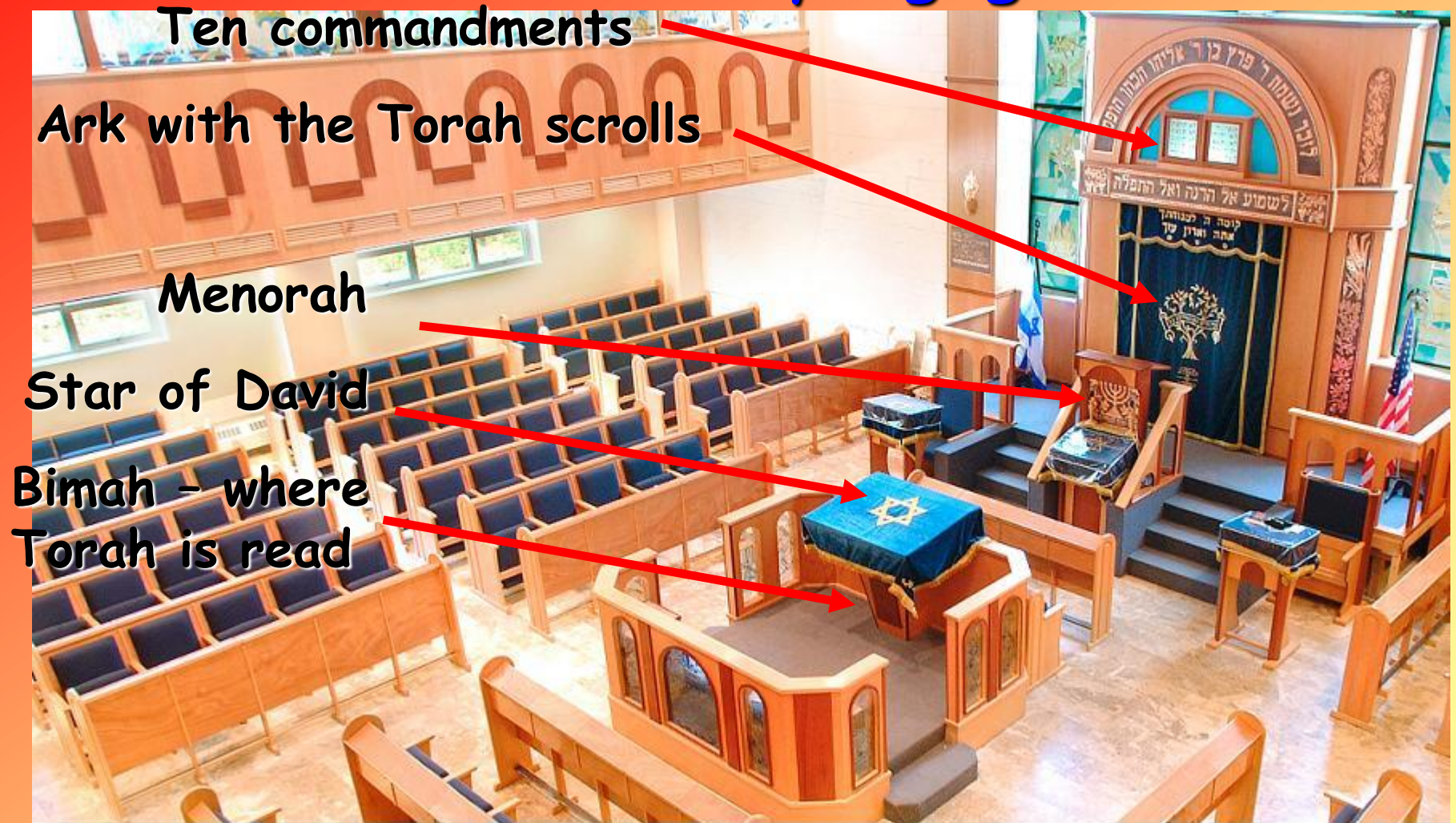
Well done! Their place of worship synagogue.

That's right - fa'isha Sikh Gur'dwara



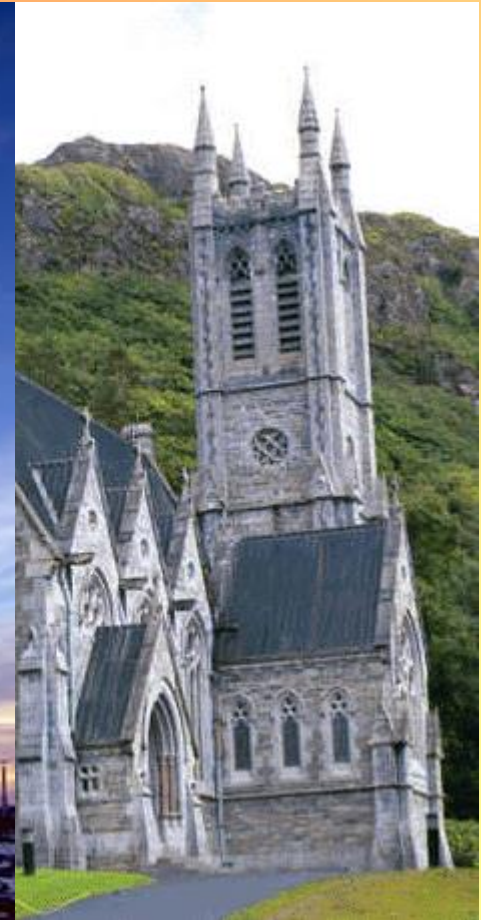
Can you see the Khanda here too - the Sikh symbol.
