

Instructions for Maths Lesson 1- 11th January

1. For this lesson you will need a pencil and a piece of paper or your green homework book.

If you have a dice and some number cards (you can just cut up paper and write the numbers 1-10 on them) that would be handy. Or you can have a go at making your own spinner (see below)

1. Warm up your maths brain - Practise counting from 10 to 20 and back again. You might enjoy this video;

2. Have a look at this video- [Spring1.2.1 - Add by counting on activity on Vimeo](#) this will include questions to answer along the way. The video shows the PowerPoint with a voice-over to explain and teach the children as the input. It instructs when to pause the video to answer the questions then giving the answers shortly after. (The PowerPoint without the voice over is also accessible if you prefer that)
3. Have a go at the counting on game- take a number card and then roll the dice or spin your spinner and count on. You can use a number line too if that helps.
4. Have a look at the 'Extra maths games and challenges' -pick a couple to get your number brain working!
