

Week 3 Phonics – ch sh th ng

Over the, week feel free to try these simple phonics lessons with your child. Make sure to revisit flash cards of phase 3 using the phonics play website.

Day One - Phonics sound 1- ch

Activity 1: Reading

Write the words chip, chick and lunch (bonus word chain) can the children draw these?

Activity 2: Writing

Have a go at writing the words with your child.

Show them how to write it in a sentence or encourage them to do this independently. (A chick can run and jump)

Day Two - Phonics sound 2- sh

Activity 1: Reading

Write the words sheep, ship and sheets on a piece of paper. Can the children read them and draw a picture?

Activity 2: Writing

Have a go at writing the words with your child.

Show them how to write it in a sentence or encourage them to do this independently. (the sheep is on the grass.)

Day Three - Phonics sound 3- th

Activity 1: Reading

Write the words thin, three and thorn on a piece of paper. Can the children read them and draw a picture?

Activity 2: Writing

Have a go at writing the words with your child.

Show them how to write it in a sentence or encourage them to do this independently. I can see three sheep.

Day four - Phonics sound 3- ng

Activity 1: Reading

Write the words sing, king and ring on a piece of paper. Can the children read them and draw a picture?

Activity 2: Writing

Have a go at writing the words with your child.

Show them how to write it in a sentence or encourage them to do this independently. The king can sing.

Day Five – tricky words she, me was

Activity 1: Reading

Use the Tricky Tracker. Play hunt the word. Can you find go, was and my on the tricky tracker? How many of each word can you find? Read across the Tricky Tracker saying each word as you point to it.

Think of a sentence for each word. Eg Sh went to the shop.

Activity 2: Writing

Have a go at writing the words.

Extension – can you write a sentence with each word in?
