It stands to the side and opposite the pub.



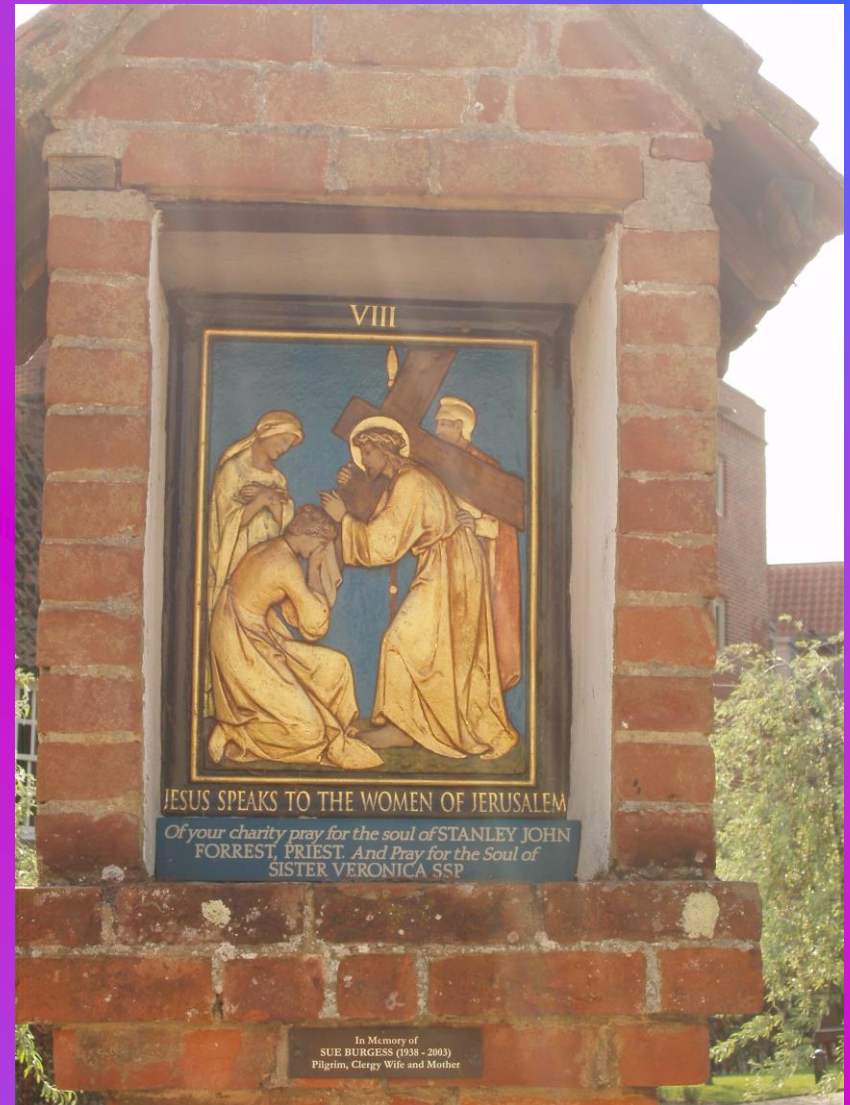
Once inside, there is a noticeable peace.

replacing the 11th century original which stood partly on this site—represents the Holy House at Nazareth in which the Archangel Gabriel brought tidings to Blessed Mary—

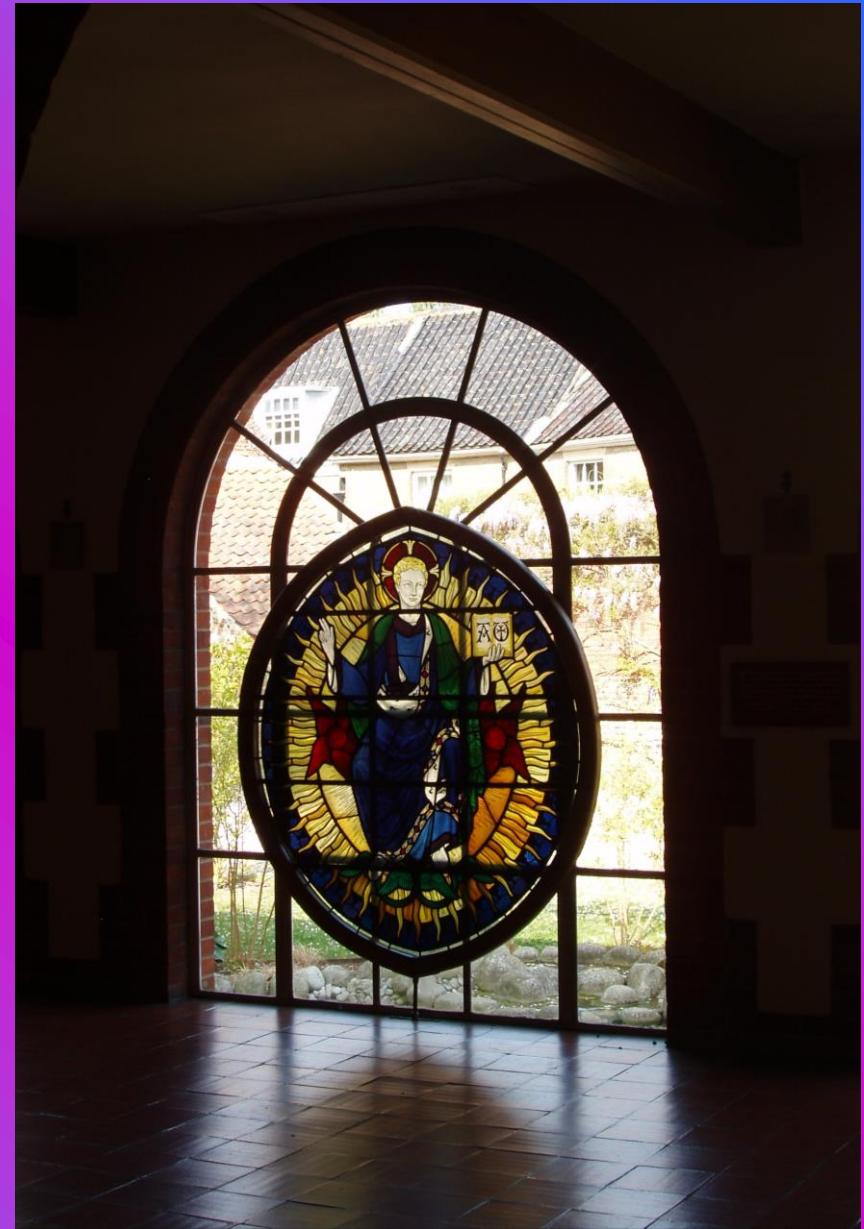
The Statue enshrined in it is a copy of that shown on the ancient Seal of the place and is venerated by the many pilgrims who come here to ask for the prayers of Holy Mary the Mother of God in their various needs.

Every night at 6 p.m. are presented the many intercessions sent in from all over the world.

The prayers of all of us help other people, even though we are sinners. But the prayers of Her—who by God was kept from sin and who revealed Herself on this spot in 1061, are the most powerful

THE HOLY WELL

This Well of 11th century stone-work is the one which was discovered when the Shrine was re-built in 1931.
