Remember to 'pinch' your pencil when mark making/drawing (you could practise writing or copying the letters from your name too)








Weekly Activities- how many stars can you collect?

favourite part of the story? Can you join in with any of the repeated phrases from the story? If you were a superhero- what would your superpower be?

Make your own jelly!

What is your favourite fruit? Can vou make a jelly trapping



some of your favourite fruits inside just like the evil pea?



Observe and talk about the changes when making jelly- how does it start off? What words can you use to describe it? What is it like when it is set?

What is your favourite fruit? Can you use your mark making skills to draw a picture of it?
