Week 1.

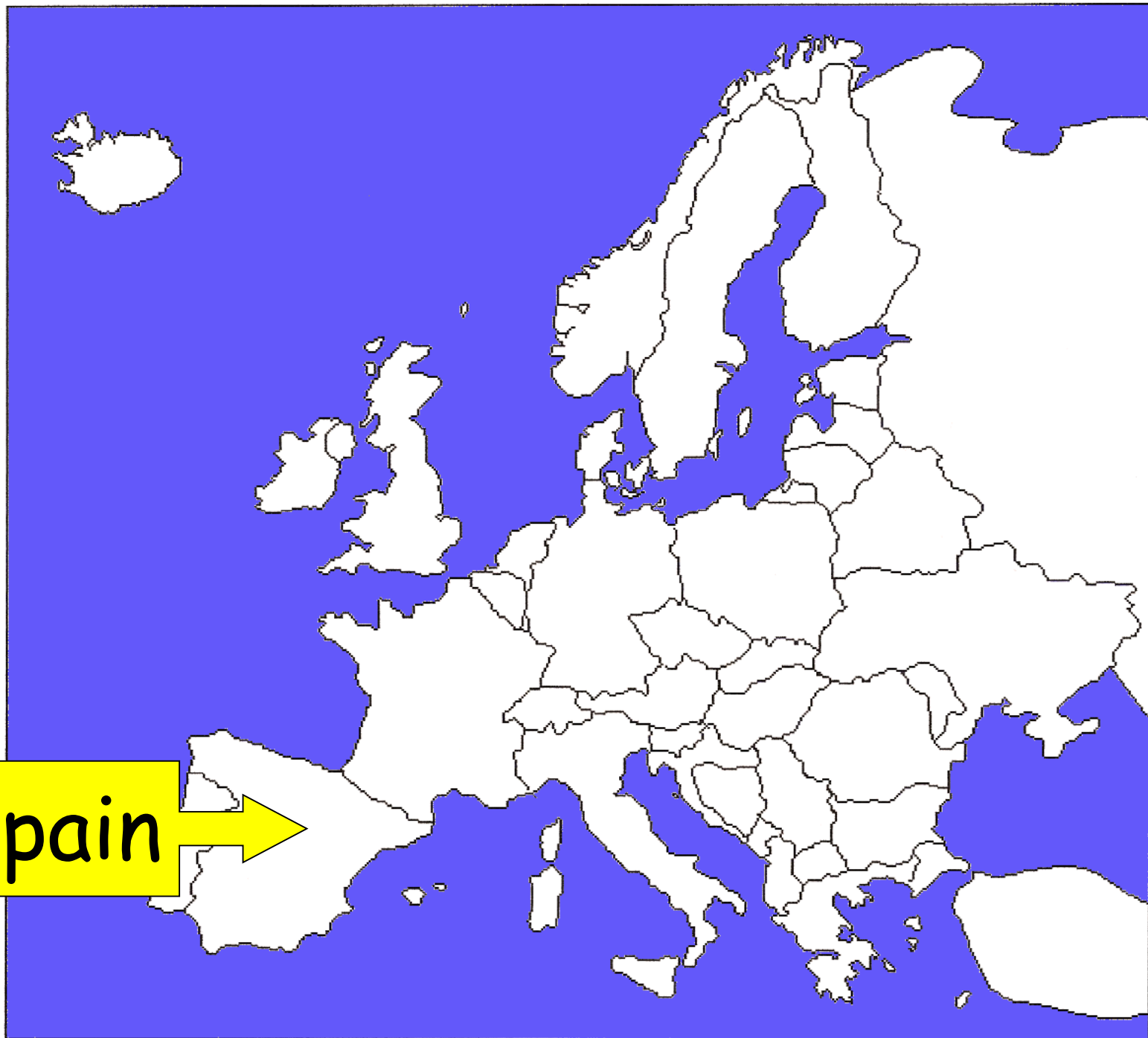

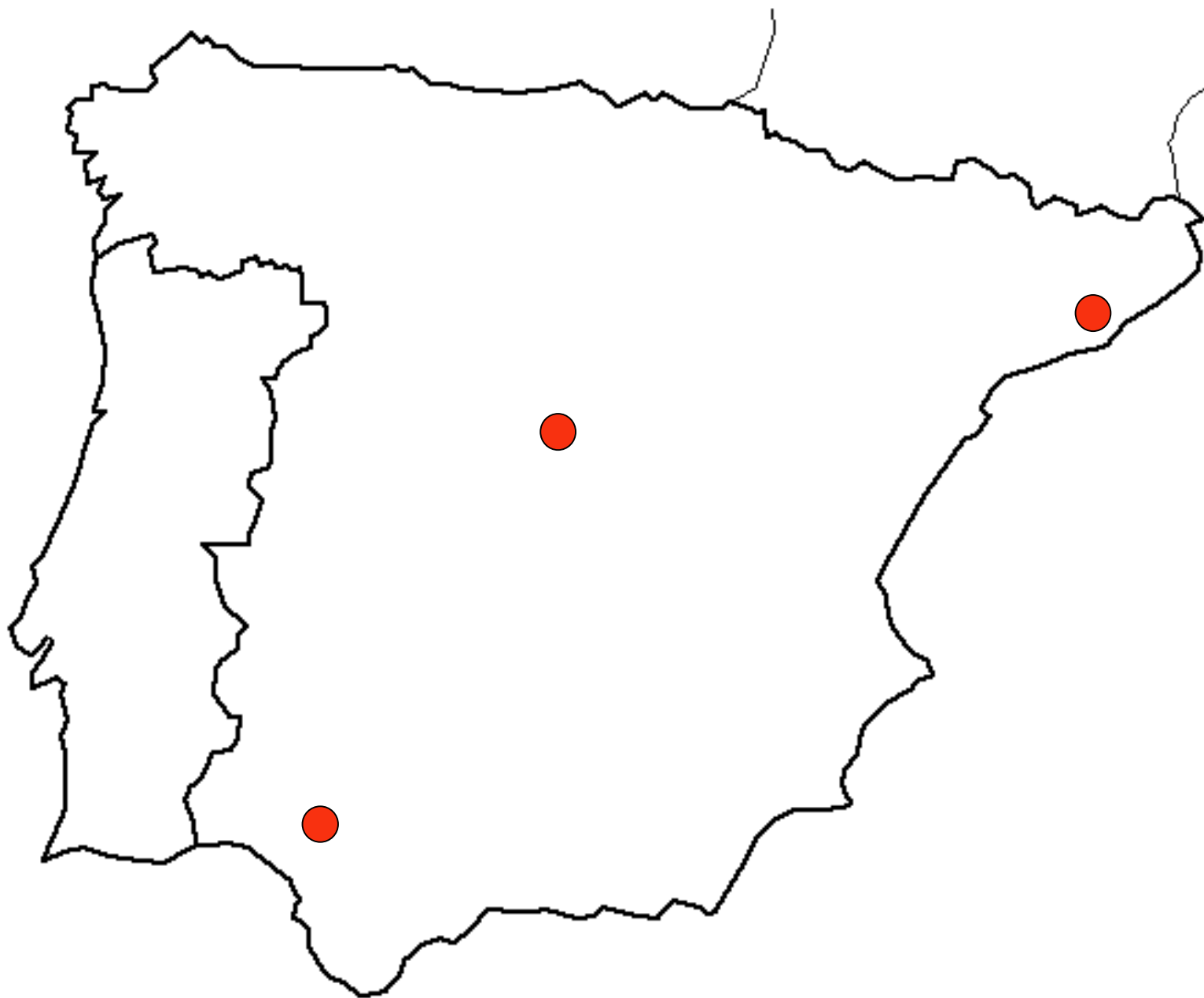
