



Over the next few slides, you will see pictures of gardens. You need to write down all the decorative items you can see. Make a list and write them all down. Let's see how many you can get!


































- Today, we are going to be designing a garden for someone who faces a particular challenge.
- Can you think of people who may face particular challenges?
- One example might be someone who is blind

 You are going to have this lesson and the next 2 lessons to design your garden of dreams for someone who faces a challenge.



What might someone who is hard of hearing want in a garden?

What might someone who is visually impaired want in a garden?

What might someone who is in a wheelchair want in a garden?

What might a child who has no outdoor space want in a garden?



The task involves:

- Choosing who the garden is for
- Designing the garden and making a poster showing the design
- Plan an 'opening event' for the garden opening
- Deciding on costs: You will only have a certain amount to spend
- At the end of the task you will present your garden design to the class, explaining your ideas.

Roles:

Landscaper: draw the finished design onto the poster. Budgeters: keep track of the costs so that you don't spend too much Event planner: plan the opening event for the garden.
