# Brooch (noun)

## Definition:

A small piece of jewellery with a pin at the back that is fastened to a woman's clothes.

## In context:

The queen wore a brooch on her jacket.



# Iceni (noun)

## Definition:

A tribe of British people during the Iron Age / Early Roman times.

## In context:

The Iceni Tribe was led by Boudicca.



# Significant (adjective)

## Definition:

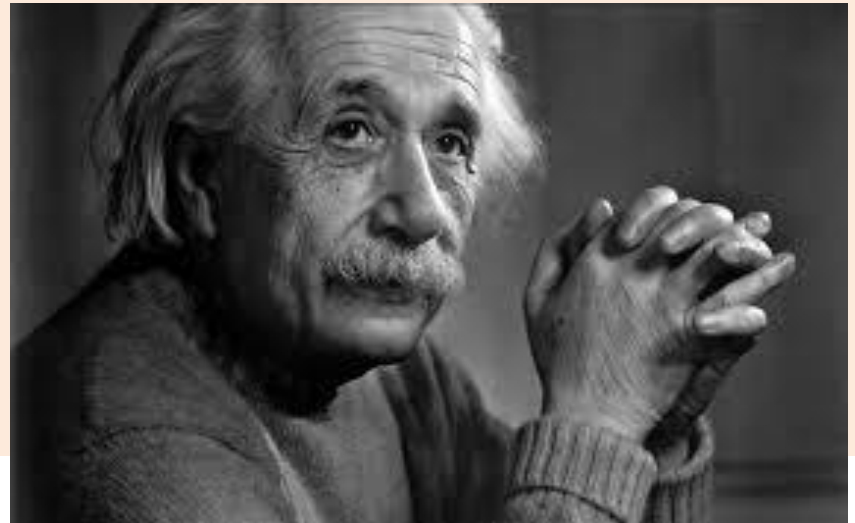
Important and worthy of attention.

## In context:

Einstein is a significant person

## Synonyms:

important, great,  
powerful, symbolic



# Defeated (adjective)

## Definition:

Beaten in a battle or other contest.

## In context:

The Celts were defeated

## Synonym:

conquered, lost  
overcome, crushed



# Occupied (Verb)

## Definition:

An area taken control of by armies or a place that is lived in.

## In context:

France was occupied by the Romans by 117 AD.

## Synonyms:

Inhabited, populated, settled



# Taxes (noun)

## Definition:

An amount of money you pay to the government so that it can pay for public services such as roads and schools.

## In Context

Each month, I pay my taxes.



# Heroines (noun)

## Definition:

A woman with superhuman qualities.

## In context:

The heroine saved the boys life by catching him when he fell.





# Withdraw (verb)

## Definition:

The action or process of falling back.

## In context:

The Romans had to withdraw from Britain when Emperor Claudius was the ruler.

## Synonym:

Pull back, leave, quit.
