Can you listen to the story a few times, so you know it really well!

You could also look for other stories that have vegetables in them. We love 'Oliver's Vegetables' by Vivian French and 'Eat your Peas' by Kes Gray.



Count everything and anything!

It could be the toys you are playing with, how many stairs there are in your house or even how many vegetables you have left on your plate!



Try to make into a game/as fun as possible e.g. 'I bet you can't count how many dinosaurs you have?'

Draw and mark make away-

Remember to 'pinch' your pencil when mark making/drawing (you could practise writing or copying the letters from your name too)

Make vegetable soup


Can you help to prep and carefully chop some vegetables? What

Make or draw the characters from the story


On Tuesday's zoom Mrs Stables is going to show you how to draw the people from the story. You could also draw the animals and get an adult to


