## Make a poster – Instructions

You can make your poster about any animal that you would like. Here is the information we would like to see on your poster:

## ✓ A title

- ✓ A drawing or picture of your chosen animal
- ✓ What classification your animal is e.g. mammal
  - ✓ Where your animal lives
  - ✓ What your animal eats
- ✓ Features of your animal e.g. 2 wings, beak, feathers
  - ✓ Is it a carnivore, herbivore or an omnivore?

You can use any materials you have at home to make your poster. You can also you your ICT skills if you wish and make you poster using a laptop or an iPad. Remember, we are thinking about **non-fiction** texts, so you need to use real and factual information on your poster.
