Definition:

Christmas is a traditional festival

Synonyms:

Conventional, established

outraged (verb – past tense)

Definition:

When a person is very angry and shocked. Or to badly break the rules.

In context:

The public were outraged when there were no toilet rolls.

Their behaviour outraged all the rules

Synonyms:

Anger, infuriate, enrage

Raise (verb)

Definition:

To increase the amount, strength and to build

In context: Boudicca raised an army.

Synonyms:

Increase, put up, build



Tolerate (verb)

Definition:

To allow something to happen without trying to stop it.

In context: The teacher tolerated the noisy children

Synonym:

Allow, permit,



Drive (Verb)

Definition:

To move with force in a specific direction

In context:

The Iceni were driven back by the Romans

Synonyms:

To push, power, move.

Flee (verb)

Definition:

To run away from a place or person that is dangerous.

In Context:

To escape the fighting they were forced to flee the village.

Synonyms: to run, take flight, escape



Humiliated (verb past tense)

Definition:

To feel ashamed and foolish.

In context:

You humiliated me in front of the school.

Synonyms:

Embarrass, mortify, shame



Smuggled (verb past tense)

Definition:

To move something illegally into or out of somewhere.

In context: he smuggled a message to

the prisoners
