

Counting to 50 by making 10's

1. Warm up:

Join in this action song – its great for a quick wake and shake break during the day if the children have been sat for a long time too. [1 - 50 song](#)

2. Have a piece of paper and a pencil ready to interact with the video.

3. Watch the video [here](#) You can pause the video as and where you need to.

4. There is no worksheet for this session. The children need to have lots of practical experience of counting larger numbers.

Teaching tips!

Have another go at these activities from the last session.

Practice counting forwards and backwards from 0-50 so the children are confident about where each number comes on the numberline. Support them in bridging the 10's numbers if this is where they get stuck.

Practically count large numbers of objects e.g coins, counters, marbles, pasta pieces, straws etc. Model how it is easier to count these objects if we group them into groups of 10.

Challenge them: Can you make a model with 50 lego pieces?

Can you thread 37 pasta pieces onto a thread to make a necklace?

Can you put 42 coins into the jar?

Can you make me 32 mini balls of playdough?

Can you find me the 44 pennies I have hidden in the room?
