(Transport)

b. Do the picture labelling exercise. Look at the French word boxes. Remember that un and une both mean 'a' in French. Un is for masculine words, une is for feminine words. Copy the French carefully above the word, then write what it means below in English.

c. Match the words with the pictures. You could also play a game. Have the words face down on one side, and the pictures face down on another. Can you turn over a word and find its matching picture?
