# wares (noun)

## Definition:

Goods or merchandise that can be sold

**In context:** The man sold his wares on the market.

**Synonyms:** goods, produce



# Revere (verb)

## Definition:

To give respect to

**In context:** The boy revered his grandfather

**Synonyms:** regard, respect  
admire

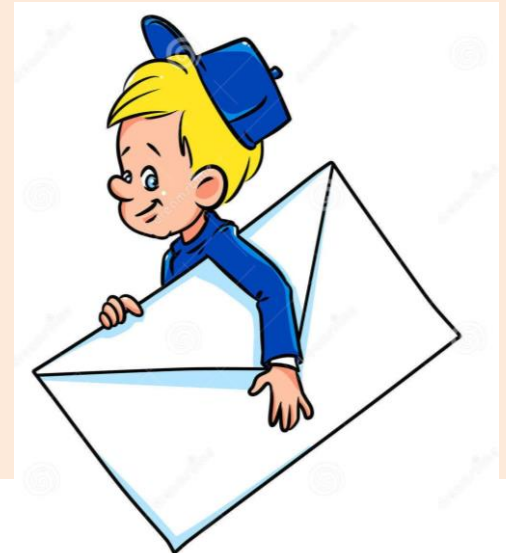


# Emissaries (noun)

**Definition:** Someone who is sent on a mission or errand

**In Context:** The soldier was sent to Wales to inform the army about Boudicca's attack

**Synonyms:** messenger



# Elders (noun)

**Definition:** Someone who is older than you

**In context:** We are taught to respect our elders

**Synonyms:** senior



# Ornate (adjective)

**Definition:** something that has a lot of decoration and is fancy

**In context:** The Roman's shield was ornate

**Synonym:** beautiful, elegant, opulent



# Arrogant (adjective)

**Definition:** Behaving as though you have more importance than someone else.

**In context:** The man at the bank acted arrogant towards his customer.

**Synonym:** bossy, cocky



# Fleet (noun)

**Definition:** A group of ships under command

**In context:** The fleet docked during the night.





# Brigands (noun)

**Definition:** Someone who robs people. Usually in the forest or mountains.

**In context:** The brigands took her most prized possession.

**Synonym:** bandit, thief, robber



# Frescoes (noun)

**Definition:** A type of watercolour painting.

**In context:** The frescoes were painted on the ceiling of the building.
