Log on to Bug club and have a go at the quiz questions throughout the book.

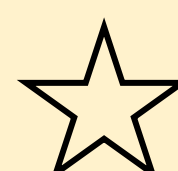
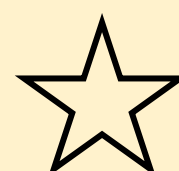
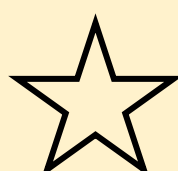
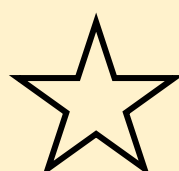
Activity - Art

Number:

Use your number cards to put in the correct order each day. Can you count backwards from 20? Take some cards out of the line. Can you explain how you know which ones are missing?
