

Let's remind ourselves from last week. What are the 5 vowels?

The 5 vowels are: **a, e, i, o** and **u**

- There are **short vowel sounds** e.g in the words:

slid

hid

fin

- There are also **long vowel sounds** (the long vowel sounds are also the names of the letters). This is when we use the **split vowel digraph** and add the 'e' at the end of the word.
