Parents: Get a tray or large plate and look around your house for plant seeds, leaves, stems, bulbs and beans. (check the spice rack too! And don't forget the fridge or cupboard for things like potatoes, lentils, chickpeas, apple pips) Have your child look at the natural objects. Which ones are similar? Can you group any of them? Which are different?	Make puppets for Jack and the Beanstalk Check our web page for some resources or draw your own. Take a photo of your child cutting out and send it in on Teams assignments. We are looking for holding scissors correctly, cutting close to the line and nice control.	Go to Kids Cosmic Yoga and try the first 3 challenges of "Sharks Bay" Pick from Norris the Baby Sea Horse, Moana, Popcorn the Dolphin, Squish the Fish or Nibs the Octopus If your child is enjoying the Cosmic Yoga sessions, you can sign up to the website to gain access to a map activity. With this, you go through different Cosmic Kids adventures and tick off on your map as you go. You even get a certificate. This does ask you to get emails from Cosmic Kids and we only want you to do three from YouTube, you don't need to sign up.	Look at the I-Spy 9 and 10 sheets. Create your own sheets to represent 9 or 10. You could draw objects, dominoes, numicon shapes, ladybird spots, use 10 frames there are lots of different ways you can represent each number. How many different ways can you show? When you have made your sheets upload a photo of them onto Teams for your maths homework this week.

Paint printing with leaves: Find some medium ever-green leaves on a walk (look at hedges and basil bushes etc) First paint or draw a green line and then put green paint on the leaves. Press them firmly against the paper to print leave shapes onto your beanstalk. Why not add some cotton wool at the top using tape or PVA glue to make it look like it is going into the clouds?	Look at the picture on our webpage and talk about what you can see. Think of a sentence or caption you could write about it. Could it be the castle that the giant lives in? Who else might live in the castle?
