This week, we are looking at words where the **shun** ending is made using 'ssion'.

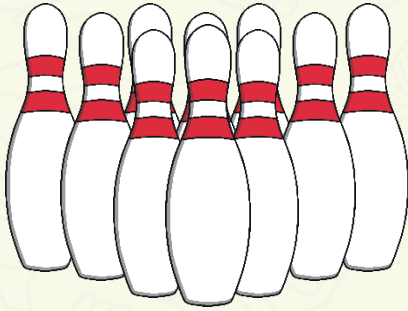


This usually happens in
