Suffixes: -cian, -sion, -tion, -ssion



Remember the rules: (sadly there are a few exceptions though)

- '-cian': common in occupations
- '-tion': the most common ending, when the root word ends in 't' or 'te'.
- '-sion': where the base word ends in 'd'/'de' or 's'/'se'
- '-ation': long 'a' is always followed by -tion
- '-ssion' if the root word ends in 'ss' or 'mit'

<u>-cian</u>	<u>-sion</u>	<u>-tion</u>	<u>-ssion</u>
